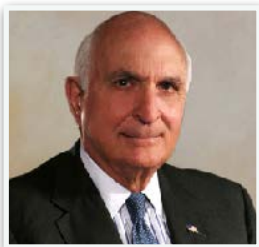
The Carlyle family wealth-holder community includes 250 families & 900 members from around the world, with combined investible assets approaching \$180 billion.

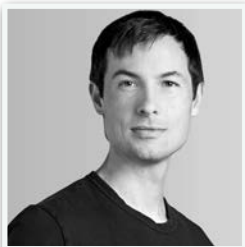

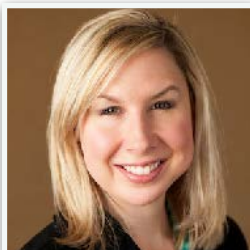

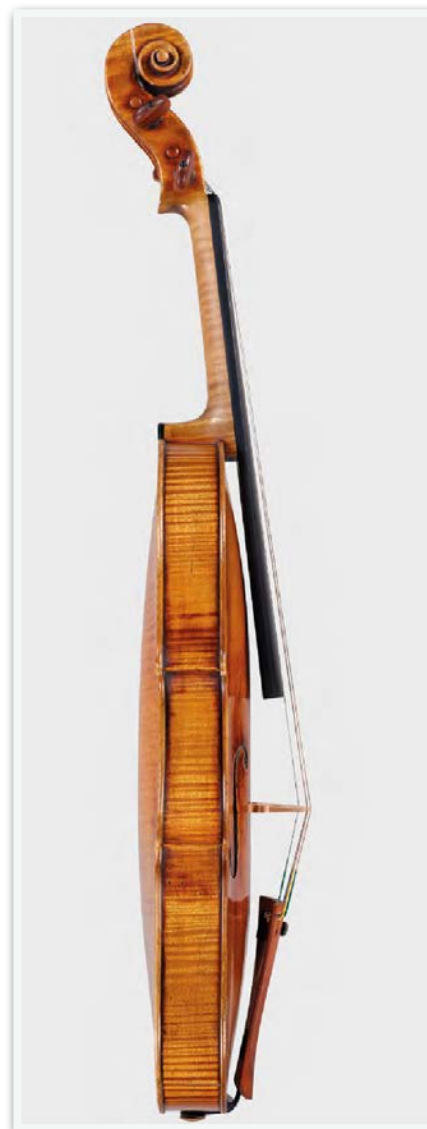

This exhibition has been created specially for Carlyle guests to view on Monday Sept. 14 & Tuesday September 15:

Antonio Stradivari stands as the most celebrated violin maker in history, a figure whose name has become synonymous with perfection in sound, craftsmanship, and artistry.

Throughout his career, Stradivari pursued relentless improvement. His designs evolved from the elegant Amati-influenced models of his early years to the powerful, refined instruments of his "Golden Period" (roughly 1700–1720), widely regarded as the pinnacle of the craft.

During this Golden Period, Stradivari achieved a near-mythical balance of form and function.

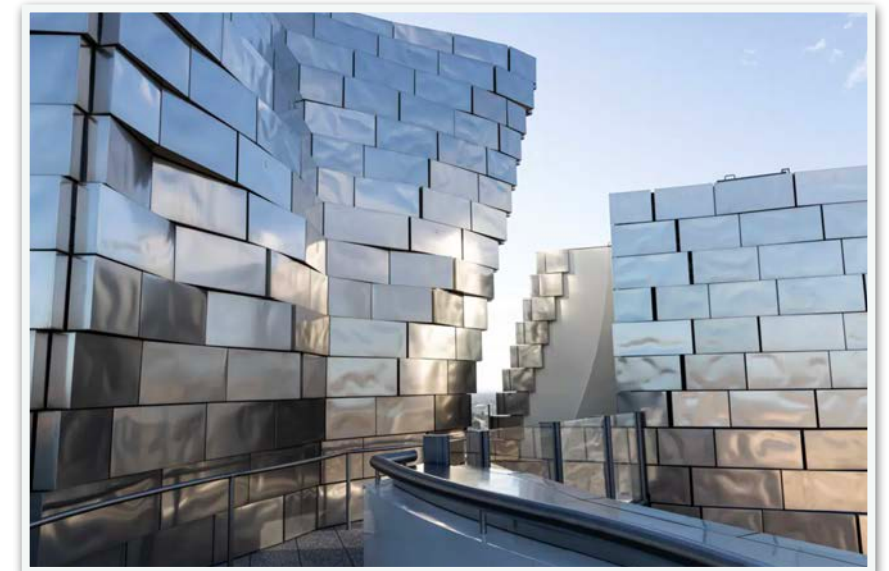

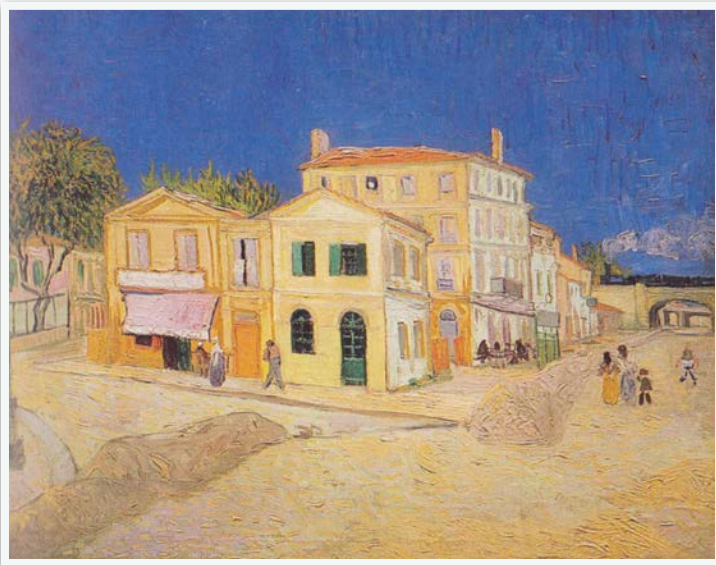
